GIRALDA AVENUE – SATURDAY WORK NOTIFICATION & WEEK OF MAY 30th

The following construction schedule is subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances and/or weather conditions. Access will be maintained at all times.

GIRALDA AVENUE

The installation of water main pipes, fire hydrants, and water meter work is currently being installed by Miami-Dade County Water & Sewer Department (WASD). This work began on May 9, 2016 and is currently on-going. The street will continue to be closed to vehicular traffic during the day and will be opened daily at the end of each work day.

GALIANO STREET

The intersection of Galiano and Giralda Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic the week of May 30th to allow the contractor to complete the installation of water main pipes, fire hydrants, and water meter work that is currently being installed by WASD. Work in this area is anticipated to continue into the week of June 6th. Expect detours.

WEEKEND WORK

WASD will be working this **Saturday, June 4th** and anticipate working on Saturday, June 11th.

Please note that due to the rain Miami-Dade County is running approximately 2 to 3 days behind schedule.

The Water Main and Water Service replacement work being installed by WASD is on-going. It is anticipated to have the Water Main and Water Service replacement work completed by June 19, 2016.
