CONSTRUCTION UPDATE*

MIRACLE MILE

The roadway reconstruction and drainage work from Salzedo to Galiano Street will continue this week. Drainage pipe will continue to be installed in the newly opened trench and will be connected to the new drainage structures.

One lane of traffic will remain open at all times on the south side of Miracle Mile from LeJeune Road to Douglas Road. Please note that there will be no night time closures this week.

Pedestrian access to the stores will be maintained at all times.

No weekend work is anticipated to be performed on Miracle Mile at this time.

GIRALDA AVENUE – 100 BLOCK

We anticipate commencing the roadway reconstruction and drainage work the week of August 15th. The street will be closed to vehicular traffic once work begins. No night work is anticipated to be performed at this time.

Pedestrian access to the businesses will be maintained at all times.

No weekend work is anticipated to be performed on Giralda Avenue at this time.
