CONSTRUCTION UPDATE*

Simultaneous roadway reconstruction and drainage work along Miracle Mile from Salzedo to Galiano Streets and Giralda Avenue from Ponce de Leon Boulevard to Galiano Street is underway.

Trench for on-street drainage system.	Complete
Connection of new drainage pipe to new drainage structure on the 200 block.	Complete
Connection of new drainage pipe to new drainage structure on the 100 block.	Ongoing
Installation of electrical conduits on the south side of the 100 & 200 blocks.	Complete
Creating drainfield and adding structural soil on roadway area of the 100 block.	Starting week of August 29th
Tree installation, irrigation and soil on sidewalk area on the 100 & 200 block.	Starting week of August 29th

One lane of traffic will remain open at all times on the south side of Miracle Mile from LeJeune Road to Douglas Road. Pedestrian access to the stores will be maintained at all times.

GIRALDA AVENUE – 100 BLOCK

<u>Work</u>	<u>Status</u>
Trench dug to start drainage work from Galiano Street to Ponce de Leon Boulevard.	Complete
Installation of drainage pipe to new drainage structure.	Ongoing
Creating drainfield and adding structural soil on roadway area.	Starting next week

The street is now closed to vehicular traffic. Pedestrian access to the businesses will be maintained at all times.
