

Miracle Mile & Giralda Avenue

Monday, November 14, 2016 - Sunday, November 20, 2016

The work being done this week is repetitive for the next few weeks in each block being worked on. Simultaneous roadway reconstruction work along Miracle Mile from Salzedo to Ponce de Leon Boulevard and Ponce de Leon to Galiano Street will continue this week along with work on Giralda Avenue. This work includes trench excavation, drainage work, and irrigation pipe and tree installation.

Roadway reconstruction will begin the week of November 14th in the **00 Block**. This will include the full closure of the eastbound lane (south side) of Miracle Mile from Le Jeune Road (SW 42nd Avenue) to Douglas Road (SW 37th Avenue). We will have appropriate signage advising of the detour.

The following work will be performed in stages: Milling of the road, excavate for new drainage, excavate for new electrical, structural soil for new trees, installation of new tree, installation of new irrigation, installation of new lighting and installation of new pavers and furniture.




Pedestrian access to the stores will be maintained at all times. New paths and crosswalks are temporarily being installed as construction progresses.



Construction Activities



MIRACLE MILE CONSTRUCTION – from November 14, 2016 to November 20, 2016

Block 200 – Columns light foundations for crosswalks being installed. Control panel being installed, Final piece of Duraslot being installed, Irrigation being finalized.

Block 100 –Final Oak Trees being installed, Irrigation being installed, Column Light foundations for crosswalks going in place, Control panels being installed.

Block 000- Milling for the south side (one lane) will start. This will include the full closure of the eastbound lane (south side) of Miracle Mile from Le Jeune Road (SW 42nd Avenue) to Douglas Road (SW 37th Avenue). We will have appropriate signage advising of the detour.

One lane of traffic will remain open at all times on the south side of Miracle Mile from Le Jeune Road to Douglas Road.

GIRALDA AVENUE CONSTRUCTION - from November 14, 2016 to November 20, 2016

An unforeseen condition of an existing drain was discovered last week. It will be removed and refilled. Structural Soil will be added.

Structural soil excavation and installation at the west end of Giralda continues. This material will allow tree roots to grow through the material and stop where root barriers are installed to avoid protrusion into paver area. We anticipate starting installation of trees by the end of the week.

Column light foundations will be installed.

A paver mockup is anticipated to be done on the southwest corner of Giralda Avenue this week.

The street is now closed to vehicular traffic; however, pedestrian access to the businesses will be maintained at all times for the duration of construction. Water barriers have been installed in order to separate the work zone and pedestrian traffic. Temporary crossings have been installed and will be relocated as construction continues.

MIRACLE MILE PARKING VOUCHERS



NEW HOURS! A valet station is now operating at the northeast corner of Ponce de Leon Boulevard and Giralda Avenue for lunch (11a.m. - 5p.m.) and dinner (6p.m. - 12a.m.) Monday to Saturday. There is another station on the west side of Galiano Street between Giralda Avenue and Aragon Avenue operating for lunch (11a.m. - 4p.m.) and dinner (6 - 11p.m.) Monday to Saturday. The valet station will remain open until midnight on Friday and Saturday. We will monitor valet traffic at this location for a few weeks.



JAZZ IN THE GABLES


Jazz in the Gables will be held every Tuesday starting November 15th from 6 - 7:30p.m.
