• Intersection of Salzedo Street and Miracle Mile - Sunday to Thursday from 11:00 pm. to 7:00 am.

Week of January 8, 2017

Intersection of Salzedo Street and Miracle Mile - Sunday to Thursday from 11:00 pm. to 7:00 am.

Week of January 17, 2017


In addition, Miami-Dade County Water & Sewer Department (WASD) Capital Improvement Program is planning to upgrade the water service in the City of Coral Gables. The improvements include water main and water service replacements. The work will take place on the north side of the median on Miracle Mile from Le Jeune Road (SW 42nd Avenue) going east to Douglas Road (SW 37th Avenue).

• The water main replacement is scheduled to start on January 17, 2017 at night for a maximum of 90 days, Sunday to Thursday from 10:00 pm to 10:00 am.

MIRACLE MILE CONSTRUCTION - from December 5, 2016 to December 11, 2016

Block 200 – The irrigation is being finalized and the soil is being prepared for pavers. All concrete curbs have been poured. Paver installation is anticipated to begin in two weeks, starting from the east to the west.

Block 100 – The irrigation, the foundation for the column lights at the crosswalks and control panels are all being installed. Concrete curbs are also being poured. The soil is also being prepared for the pavers. Paver installation is anticipated to begin within the next two weeks, starting from the east to the west.

Block 000 – Milling of the road on the south side (outer lane) has been completed. The excavation for the new drainage and new electrical will continue this week along with the placement of structural soil for the new trees. This will include the full closure of one eastbound lane (south side) of Miracle Mile and the adjacent street parking from Salzedo Street to Douglas Road (SW 37th Avenue). We will have appropriate signage advising of the detours.

One lane of traffic will remain open at all times on the south side of Miracle Mile from Le Jeune Road to Douglas Road.

GIRALDA AVENUE CONSTRUCTION - from December 5, 2016 to December 11, 2016

Bridalveil trees for the west side have been installed. The remaining foundations for the column lights will be installed this week.

The street is closed to vehicular traffic; however, pedestrian access to the businesses will be maintained at all times for the duration of construction. Water barriers have been installed in order to separate the work zone and pedestrian traffic. Temporary crossings have been installed and will be relocated as construction continues.

PARKING VOUCHERS

The City of Coral Gables has made parking vouchers for public parking garages available to merchants for the use of their customers. The vouchers were provided to the Business Improvement District (BID) for distribution to businesses being directly impacted by construction. Please call the BID at 305-569-0311 to pick up or ask for additional vouchers.

GIRALDA AVENUE VALET PARKING VOUCHERS

In addition to the parking vouchers provided to merchants for nearby garages, Giralda's Restaurant Row is also Offering Free Valet. In partnership with the City, Restaurant Row merchants on the 100 block of Giralda Avenue will provide complimentary valet vouchers to their customers, at their discretion. Merchants requiring additional vouchers should contact the Parking Department at 305-460-5541.

A valet station is now operating at the northeast corner of Ponce de Leon Boulevard and Giralda Avenue for lunch (11a.m. - 5p.m.) and dinner (6p.m. - 12a.m.) Monday to Saturday. There is another station on the west side of Galiano Street between Giralda Avenue and Aragon Avenue operating for lunch (11a.m. - 4p.m.) and dinner (6 - 11p.m.) Monday to Saturday. The valet station will remain open until midnight on Friday and Saturday. We will monitor valet traffic at this location for the next few weeks.




